Exodus. The Mosaic Law consisted of 613 commands that encompassed moral laws (10 commandments), civil In the Old Testament, God gave the Mosaic Law to the Israelites after leading them out of Egypt during the commandments referred to as "The Great Commandments". These are basically Love God and Love your laws, and religious laws. When Jesus came, He fulfilled the Mosaic Law and gave Christians 2 new

neighbor as yourself. Beyond these two there are approximately 47 other commands that Christians should try to

follow which reinforce the first two.
